Westkirk celebrates the Lord's Supper at each service on the second Sunday of the month (as well as during special seasonal times of the year). Open communion means that if you are a professing Christian who has put

your faith and trust in God through Jesus Christ alone and are a member in good standing at a local church anywhere, you are free to partake communion with us. If you are "between churches," the decision is one made between you and the Lord. Feel free to contact one of our pastoral staff if you are unsure.

September Communion Offering. Westkirk member, Darius Togba, and his friend, Philip Chayee of Meredith Drive Reformed Church, have teamed up to pursue what God has laid on their hearts – bringing relief, development and hope to their home county in war-torn Liberia. Former refugees of the war, the two men formed Child Relief Foundation, a non-profit organization with initial plans to build a Christian 7th thru 12th grade middle and high school that will serve over 400 young students.

At present, children in Grand Gedeh County only have access to education through the 6th grade. Less than 5% of children have the means to continue their education in distant cities due to the expense and difficulty of living away from home. Without this higher education, children must support themselves and families with subsistence labor such as hunting wild game, farming or working in mines.

Darius and Philip have already made two trips to Liberia to begin groundwork for the school. Local community and county leaders have welcomed their project with open arms by clearing bureaucratic hurdles, donating land for the school, and arranging for all volunteer labor to build the facility. Materials will be their only expense. The location of the school has already been cleared and leveled. Please consider partnering with Darius and Philip to fulfill their vision with your prayers and financial gift. Thank you and God bless!
