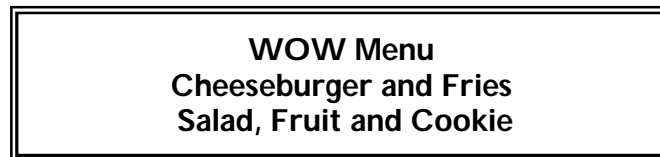
**REMINDER: Youth programs notice.** Because of the fall retreat there will be no Sunday School for middle school or high school students today. In addition, no high school program this afternoon.
