Prayer, Fasting and the Pursuit of God. Join us for Secret Church on April 26 at from 6:00 p.m. to 11:50 p.m. Our culture is constantly telling us that we can achieve anything we set our minds to. Sadly many followers of Christ and many churches have adopted this self-sufficient mindset relying on their own wisdom and abilities instead of relying on God.
