

You'll want to check each website for specifics, but generally these camps are for kids age 8 up through high school.

Ridge Haven Cono (<u>www.ridgehaven.org/cono-camps</u>) opened in 2018, and is located in northeast Iowa near Walker. It's a ministry of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA). Ridge Haven Cono features tons of great activities, including an epic slip 'n slide, and brand new camper cabins with air conditioning. Campers will have a traditional camp experience, with reformed teaching and theology.

Twin Lakes Bible Camp (<u>www.twinlakescc.com</u>) near Manson, is the one Westkirk has a long-standing relationship with. The camp is on a beautiful natural lake, there are never more than 150 campers at a time, the staff is top-notch, activities are great, and the cabins are new and air-conditioned.
