September Communion Offering. Garden Gate Ranch is the only home in Iowa for women recovering S from sex trafficking who are pregnant or have children. It is also completely faith based. Founder Brenda Long is a solid Christian woman who knows true healing comes through Jesus. The home is being renovated now with plans to open by year end.

Pathway House is Garden Gate Ranch's immediate rescue home. This home is unlike any other in the state of Iowa, filling a great need for immediate rescue — to get her off the street and into safety. While most safe homes require an interview process before admitting women to the house, the Pathway House admits first, and interviews second. They admit her—question-free—one day and then discuss options and direction with her the next. They understand that no person can plan for their tomorrow if they don't feel safe today. This reversal of interview and admittance enables women to first focus on their safety in order to finally focus on their future. With this immediate admittance, women are less likely to disappear again into the shadows of exploitation, and less likely to be victimized by yet another pimp. When Do Children Take Communion at Westkirk? Please show discernment in leading your children during communion. You may certainly take your children with you to go forward for communion. At that time, you should indicate to the server if your children are to receive the elements. Since Paul encourages us (1 Corinthians 11:23-34) to examine ourselves in order not to take the Lord's Supper in an unworthy manner, we do not subscribe to the partaking of the elements by infants, toddlers or young children (paedo-communion). We do encourage parents to talk with their children about the Gospel, about communion, and bring them to meet with one of the pastors to help them discern if their child is ready to partake. A child who is ready to take communion is also ready to publicly profess his or her faith and be baptized, if they have not already done so.
