During the first service, the communion elements are served to the congregation by the Elders. We hold each of the elements and then when directed, partake together. As part of our communion tradition, we typically stand afterwards and move toward the center aisle, placing our hand on the shoulder of the per-

son next to us and, united together, sing the Lord's Prayer. This is one of the most meaningful moments of worship each month for many at Westkirk. During the second service, two pastors or Elders will hold the elements near the chancel area and when desired, worshippers come forward and are served individually.

We have an assistive listening system purchased from the funds that have been generously given to our Memorial Gift fund, in memory of the loved ones of many of our Westkirk family. The system is called LISTEN. It can help ensure that everyone here to worship the Lord can receive a clear and interference-free experience. The receiver can sit next to you on the pew, be held in your hand, or be attached to a belt. The earpiece comfortably fits over your ear and can be used with or without hearing aids. The product is designed to be easy to use, convenient, and the volume is controlled by you. Westkirk has purchased 4 receivers to loan out during service time. We will order more to fit the demand. Please do not be ashamed to ask the Sound Technician volunteer to use a LISTEN receiver!
